Public education is a function of the State of Missouri as expressed in the Missouri Constitution, in the state statutes and in federal and state court decisions. The Constitution provides for the establishment of a State Board of Education which has general supervision of the public schools in the state. In Missouri, the state also delegates certain responsibilities to local school districts. Each district is governed by a Board of Education and administered by a professional staff. The members of the Board are elected locally and derive their responsibility and authority from the state statutes. The Board is mindful, however, that the people of the Wentzville School District are the ultimate governors of public education in the District, and that the Board is directly accountable to the people through the elective process. The Board also believes that this accountability in a shared responsibility involving district students, professional and support staff employees, the Superintendent and the people through the elective process.
