PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

Upon consideration of the motion for a preliminary injunction filed by Plaintiff MILO Worldwide LLC, of any opposition thereto, and of the entire record in this action,

It appearing to the Court that the Plaintiff MILO Worldwide LLC is likely to succeed on the merits of its action, that it will suffer irreparable injury if the requested relief is not issued, that the Defendants will not be harmed if the requested relief is issued, and that the public interest favors the entry of such an order, it is, therefore,

ORDERED that the motion of Plaintiff MILO Worldwide LLC for a preliminary injunction is hereby GRANTED; and it is further

ORDERED that Defendants Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority, Paul J. Wiedefeld, and all persons acting under their supervision or in concert with them, shall, pending

further order of this Court, re-post, as expeditiously as possible, Plaintiff's 45 Rail Poster and 200 Car Card advertisements for the book *Dangerous* that were posted in Defendant's transit system from June 26, 2017 through July 6, 2017; and it is further

ORDERED that the Rail Poster and Car Card advertisements shall continue to be posted for 18 consecutive days, unless subject to a further order of the Court, and shall be in locations of equal prominence as their prior postings; and it is further

ORDERED that this injunction shall be effective upon service on the defendants, and no bond shall be required.
